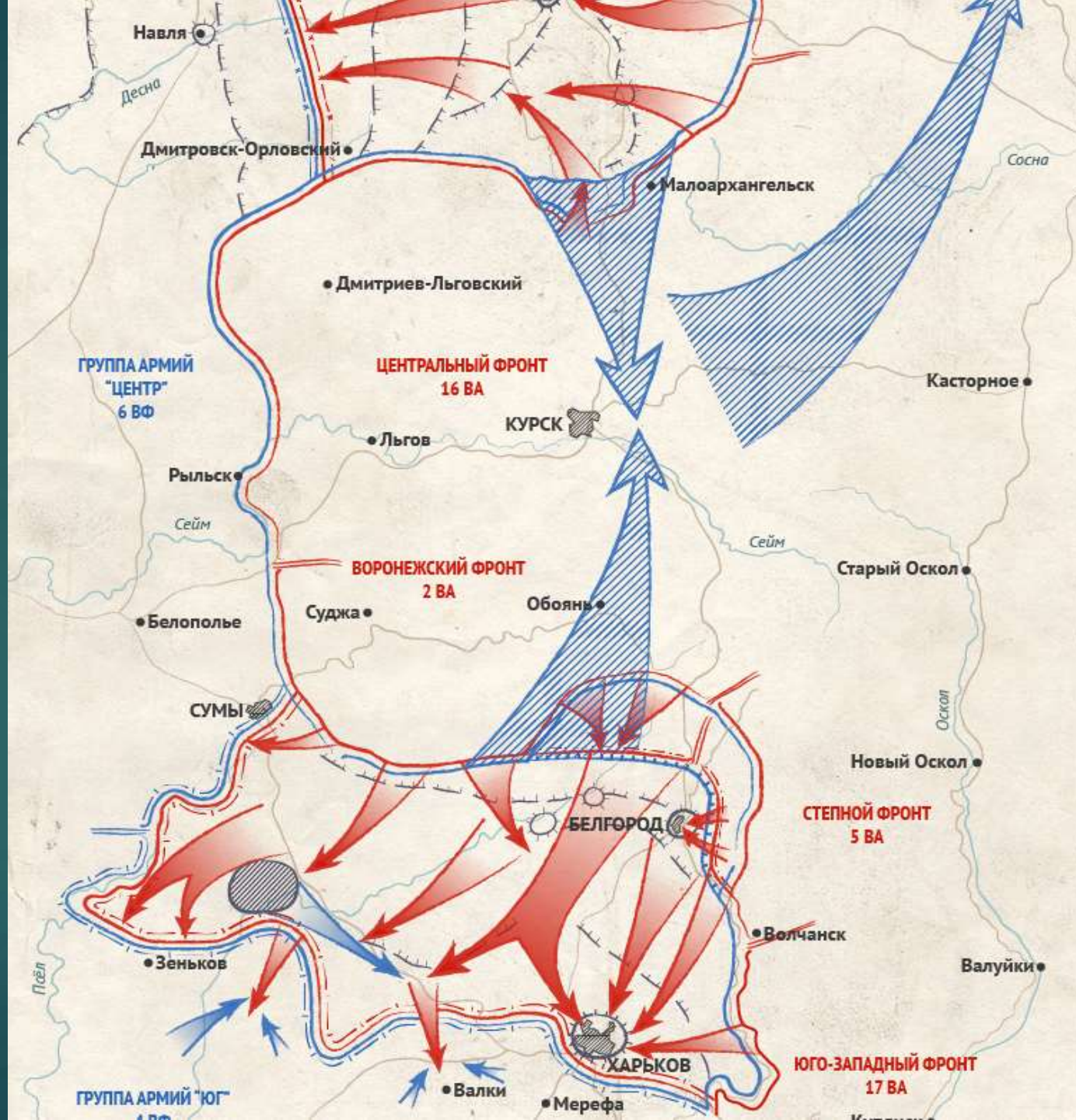

I want to tell you
about an amazing
woman, a **veteran of
the Great Patriotic
War** - my great-
grandmother
**Nekrasova Ekaterina
Yakovlevna.**



Ekaterina
Yakovlevna was born
in 1922 in the village
of Aleshnya,
Khomutovsk district,
Kursk region, in a
simple peasant
family.



In 1938 she graduated from school and was sent to work as a school teacher to the village of Petrovskoye.



In 1940 Ekaterina Yakolevna married my great-grandfather Alexander Ivanovich Nekrasov, who was the chairman of the Village Council in the same village at that time.





When the Great Patriotic War began, Alexander Ivanovich became a commissar of the partisan detachment named after F.E. Dzerzhinsky of the 2nd Kursk partisan brigade. It was a partisan detachment that my great-grandmother joined into too.



She was awarded an enormous number of medals and orders. The most valuable of which are the Medal “For Military Merit” and the Order of the Patriotic War.



After the war,
my great-
grandparents
lived and
worked in the
Kursk region
and raised 4
children.



My other great-grandfather **Mikhail Sergeevich Egorov**, was also a participant of the Great Patriotic War. He fought in Kursk Battle.

For his military and labor services, he was awarded **the Order of the Patriotic War, 1st degree**, and other **11 medals**.
